I am very pleased to see that regulations are being considered regarding senior specific designations.

This is an area of incredible abuse. Persons who take very short courses, of only a few hours, are in no way qualified to be designated as anything, not even a senior dog walker.

As you know, many elderly lose their judgement and become very susceptible to suggestion and quite impressionable. The charlatans with the phony designations are happy to take advantage of these tendencies.

However, I am not optimistic about what you may be able to do, unless Congress is willing to go so far as to install laws that control this area much the same as is done for CPAs. Anything less than that will be an exercise in frustration and a waste of time. I hope I'm wrong.

A lot of us appreciate your efforts. I hope you are at least modestly successful.
