The Office of the New Jersey State Attorney General, Bureau of Securities, located in Newark, New Jersey, is seeking investigators to conduct investigations into violations of the Uniform Securities Law, N.J.S.A. 49:3-47 to -83, including securities fraud. The Bureau is charged with protecting investors and regulates securities firms, stock brokers and investment advisers, as well as securities offerings into or from New Jersey.

Candidates must possess the ability to analyze, interpret, and apply State and Federal securities and related civil and criminal laws, rules, regulations, policy, and procedure; and review financial records and documents to identify material evidence. Strong interpersonal communications skills required to conduct in-person interviews and depositions. Strong writing skills required to prepare investigative reports and administrative orders.

Qualifications in addition to those listed above:

- Three years of investigative or comparable experience;
- Must have a valid driver's license and
- Must reside in (or intend to become a resident of) New Jersey¹.

Starting salary level is dependent upon experience and is within a range of approximately \$59K up to \$76K annually.
