

## **SECURITIES FRAUD INVESTIGATOR**

Arizona Corporation Commission Securities Division is seeking a Securities Fraud Investigator to join its Enforcement Section. The Section investigates possible violations of the Securities Act and the Investment Management Act, brings administrative and civil cases and provides assistance to prosecutors in criminal matters. A minimum of four years of investigative experience is required, with experience in financial crimes/securities and bank fraud preferred. Other required qualifications include the ability to interpret and apply state and federal securities and criminal laws, rules, regulations and statutes; the ability to prepare clear concise reports, and the ability to testify in administrative, civil or criminal proceedings as necessary. Candidate may be currently certified as a peace officer certified by the Arizona Peace Officers Standards and Training Board (AZPOST) or have previously been certified as a peace officer in Arizona or elsewhere or capable of being recertified by AZPOST through the waiver process within six months of hire. However, certification as a peace officer is not mandatory requirement at this time. Salary range is \$44,000 to \$47,039. This position is not covered by the State Merit System.
