The Arizona Corporation Commission is hiring a Securities Attorney for the Enforcement Section in its Securities Division. The Securities Division strives to preserve the integrity of the financial marketplace and deter financial fraud through investigative actions as well as the registration and oversight of securities, securities dealers and salesperson, and investment advisers and their representatives.

The successful candidate will review and analyze evidence collected by the Division's investigators, directs the investigation, including working with forensic accountant, drafts pleadings and litigates administrative and civil matters under the Arizona Securities Act and the Investment Management Act. Cases will be before administrative law judges and in state and Federal courts. The successful candidate will have experience in handling highly charged and contentious matters. This involves analyzing legal issues and providing recommendations to Securities Division management and to the Arizona Corporation Commission. Experience in the securities industry and/or financial fraud is highly suggested. Responsibilities also include assisting county, state, and Federal prosecutors in criminal prosecutions.

Ideal candidates will demonstrate the following knowledge, skills and abilities:

- Thorough knowledge of requisite legal matters, preferably in the area of securities regulation and/or financial fraud;
- Demonstrable knowledge of litigation and statutory construction;
- Legal research skills;
- Ability to handle contentious negotiations;
- Excellent communication and writing skills;
- Ability to work in a team environment; and
- Ability to effectively perform high-level, independent legal work.

Candidate must be an active member in good standing with the State Bar of Arizona or eligible to waive into the Bar. Any offer of employment will be contingent upon the candidate's satisfactory results of a background and criminal history investigation.
