The Switch Seminar/Workshop Announcement

The Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act ("Dodd-Frank Act") that became effective on July 21, 2010 brought significant changes to the regulation and oversight of investment advisers. Among these changes, the Dodd-Frank Act requires states to regulate investment advisers with assets under management up to \$100 million.

Colorado's Switch Program has been developed to assist the advisers in fulfilling this requirement in an efficient and timely fashion consistent with Colorado's securities laws and regulations that protect the marketplace and investing public

The Colorado Division of Securities will be hosting a number of Seminar/Workshops entitled "The Switch" to discuss the program, the differences between federal and state regulation, and to answer any question you may have.
